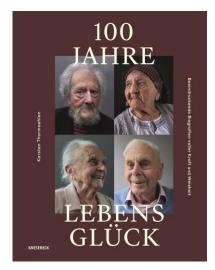

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THE NEW MASTERPIECE BY GERMANY'S NO. 1 ALPINE PHOTOGRAPHER

From December to carnival, the snow-covered Alps are transformed into a stage for centuries-old rituals - mysterious, archaic and full of symbolism. 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FASTER THAN THE SULTAN - ON FOOT FROM VIENNA TO ISTANBUL

To find his way out of a personal crisis, Martin Zinggl sets off into the unknown: on foot along the Sultan's Trail. Vienna - Istanbul, eight countries, 2400 kilometres, countless borders, visible and invisible. With time and curiosity in his luggage, he experiences new stories on old paths. The Balkans welcome him with hospitality and mistrust. Villagers harbour him, street dogs chase him, fugitives in the forest warn him: wrong way, friend!
